CASES REJECTED DURING FEBRUARY, 2012 = 01

1. M/s Saber Papers Ltd., Village Gaunspur Hambran, District Ludhiana
The case was considered by the SCA-cum-SAC in its 75th meeting held on 15.02.2012, and the Committee observed that the PPCB vide letter no. 1037 dated 10.02.2012 has recommended that clearance of site may not

be granted to the project as the project proponent has failed to submit proper water balance due to which the adequacy of the treatment system and disposal of wastewater cannot be adjudged. The Punjab Pollution Control Board has also informed that the industry has not submitted a certificate issued by the Competent Authority showing the designation of the area as per the Master Plan in which the proposed site of the industrial plant is located.

The Committee further observed that there will be intensive use of water in the proposed industrial plant, as such, it is mandatory on the part of the industry to submit proper water balance chart to ascertain the adequacy of the proposed treatment system and disposal arrangement, but the industry has not yet submitted proper water balance chart. Furthermore, as per application, the industry shall generate substantial quantity of wastewater and for the disposal of the same, adequate land area is required to be developed, but the industry does not have sufficient area to develop the same for discharge of treated wastewater. Therefore, in light of above noted observations, the case is liable to be refused. However, as regards to another observation of the Punjab Pollution Control Board to the effect that the project proponent has not submitted classification of the area as per Master Plan in which the proposed site of the industrial plant is located, the Department of Town & Country Planning has informed vide letter no. 125 dated 06.01.2012 to the SCA-cum-SAC that the site of the industry is located in the industrial zone as per the notified Master Plan of Ludhiana.

After detailed discussions and in view of the recommendations of Punjab Pollution Control Board, it was decided to refuse environmental clearance under Press Note 17 (1984 Series) and to recommend refusal of site clearance under the Factories Act, 1948.

M/s Garg International, Village Dugri, Tehsil Payal, District Ludhiana	<p>The case was considered by the SCA-cum-SAC in its 75th meeting held on 15.02.2012, and Committee observed that the PCCF vide letter No. 3575 dated 16.01.2012 has informed that forest land is affected with the approach to the industrial premises from the Scheduled road and the user agency has submitted the case for obtaining permission from Govt. of India, Ministry of Environment & Forests, under the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980.</p> <p>It was further observed by the Committee that as per the policy decision taken in the cases of new industries, where forest land is affected, the entrepreneur is required to obtain prior permission from the Ministry of Environment & Forests, under the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for using the forest land as an approach to the industrial plant, prior to the case is considered by the Committee.</p> <p>After discussions, it was decided to convey the observations of PCCF to the entrepreneur for making compliance of the same and to defer the case till the industry obtains the requisite permission under the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980.</p>

3. M/s Tools Technologies, F-237, Phase-8, Focal Point, Ludhiana The case was considered by the SCA-cum-SAC in its 75th meeting held on 15.02.2012, and Committee observed that DOF vide letter 1465-B dated 01.02.2012 has conveyed to the industry with a copy of the same to the Committee that the On-site Emergency Plan submitted by it is not as per Schedule 8-A of the Punjab Major Accident Hazardous Rules and copy of health & safety policy has not been submitted by the entrepreneur.

It was informed that no response has been received from the industry with regards to the observations conveyed by the DOF to the industry.

After discussions, it was decided to convey the aforementioned observations of DOF to the entrepreneur for making compliance of the same and to defer the case till the industry complies with the said observations.
